

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 29.415 and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 27.03 (2) (e) is created to read:

(e) Molluscs

Higgins eye pearly mussel - *Lampsilis higginsii*

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 22, 1977.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
