# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.09, 227.014 and 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules as follows:


### SECTION 1 - Section NR 26.01 (11) is created to read:

(11) Columbia county. (a) Lake Columbia. Those portions of the lake known as Lake Columbia located in sections 27, 33 and 34, township 12 north, range 9 east, and sections 3 and 4, township 11 north, range 9 east, beginning at the intake and outfall structures of the columbia generating station and extending 2400 feet due south.

#### SECTION 2 - Section NR 26.26 is created to read:

NR 26.26 Fish refuges. The following described areas are hereby created and established as fish refuges and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, catch, disturb, capture, kill or fish for fish in any manner from December 1 through March 30 each year, both dates inclusive, in, on or along the following described water areas:

(11) Columbia county. (a) Lake Columbia. That lake known as Lake Columbia located in sections 27, 33 and 34, township 12 north, range 9 east, and sections 3 and 4, township 11 north, range 9 east.



The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin

Natural Resources Board on August 24, 1978 and November 15, 1978.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
