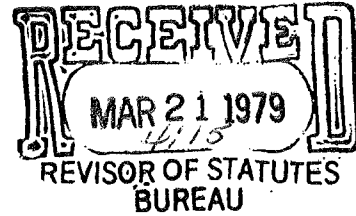

ORDER OF THE WATCHMAKING EXAMINING BOARD AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Watchmaking Examining Board by sections 15.08, the Board hereby amends and repeals rules as follows:

Sections Watch. 1.04, 1.05, 1.06 and 1.14 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are repealed.

Section Watch. 1.16 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

The board shall issue only one large embossed certificate to a registered watchmaker. Upon proof, satisfactory to the board that a certificate has been lost or destroyed, the board may issue a new certificate upon the payment of \$5.00.

The amendements contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1979.
