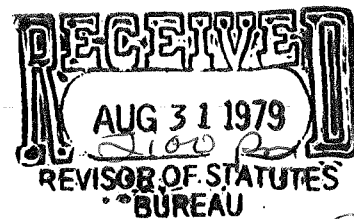

An order to create sec. 3.04 of the rules of the State of Wisconsin Ethics Board, relating to written transcripts of hearings in contested cases.

Analysis by Ethics Board

Sec. 227.07(8), Stats., provides with respect to contested cases:

227.07(8) * * * Each agency may establish rules relating to the transcript of the record into a written transcript and the providing of free copies of the written transcript.

* * *

If any agency does not adopt such rules, then it must transcribe the record and provide free copies of written transcripts upon request. In any event, an agency shall not refuse to provide a written transcript if the person making the request pays a reasonable compensatory fee for the transcription and for the copy.

* * * *

This rule provides that hearings conducted by the Ethics Board to determine whether the Code of Ethics has been violated will be transcribed and one copy of the transcript will be furnished each party free of charge upon request. Additional copies of transcripts will be furnished upon request and upon payment of appropriate charges in advance.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Ethics Board by sec. 19.48(1) and Chapter 277, Stats., the Ethics Board orders:

Section Eth 3.04 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

Eth 3.04 Transcripts.

(1) Proceedings of hearings conducted by the Ethics Board to determine whether a violation of Subchapter III, Chapter 19, Stats., has occurred, will be transcribed and one copy of the transcript will be furnished each party free of charge upon request made prior to the hearing's conclusion. Otherwise copies of transcripts will be furnished upon request and upon payment, in advance, of actual costs thereof as determined by the Board.
