#### ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

#### AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending sections NR 110.05(3)(b) and (4)(b) intro. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to extending the deadline for compliance with effluent limitations to 1983.

### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

In Chapter 34, Laws of 1979, section 147.04, Wisconsin Statutes, was amended to require communities to provide best practicable waste treatment technology (BPWTT) by July 1, 1983. Sections NR 110.05(3)(b) and (4)(b) require amendment to change the date at which publicly owned treatment works must conform to effluent limitations without bypasses and/or overflows for the Department to grant requests for sewer extensions from July 1, 1982 to July 1, 1983 to conform with the change in legislative intent.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 144.025(2)(c), 144.04, 227.014 and 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting section 144.04, Wisconsin Statutes, as follows:

#### SECTION 1 - Section NR 110.05 (3) (b) is amended to read:

(b) Requests for sewer extensions otherwise prohibited by this subsection may be approved if the owner of the treatment works, or the owner of the sewerage system, submits to the department an acceptable program to assure provision of the appropriate effluent quality, with no dry weather bypass(es) or overflow(s), by July 1, 1982 1983. The program must include a time schedule for completion of the necessary construction or upgrading. It must also include proof of financial ability and commitment to complete the program in accordance with the time schedule.

SECTION 3 - Section NR 110.05 (4) (b) intro. is amended to read:

(b) In the event the applicant submits a program for correction which includes a time schedule extending beyond July 1, 1982 1983, the following procedure will be employed:

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 20, 1979.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication as provided under section 227.026, Wisconsin Statutes.
