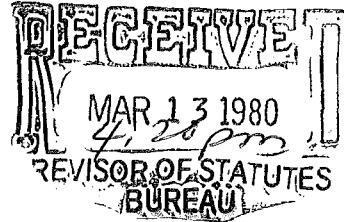



(4) Manufactured multi-family dwelling fees. Fees related to plan examination inplant and field inspections, inspector certification, Wisconsin insignias, and materials approval shall be submitted in accordance with the following:

- (a) Plan examination and approval See s. Ind 69.09 (1) (a)-(g).
- (b) Field inspection See s. Ind 69.09 (3).
- (c) Wisconsin insignia \$10.00 per living unit.
- (d) In-plant inspections by department . . \$15.00 per hour plus travel expenses
- (e) Materials approval \$200.00 per model
- (f) Certified inspector

2. Training course and examination	\$75.00	--

- (g) Third party certification \$100.00 initially
