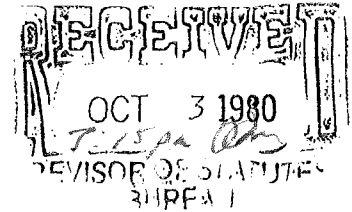

I further certify that this copy has been compared by me with the original on file in this board and that the same is a true copy thereof, and of the whole of the original.

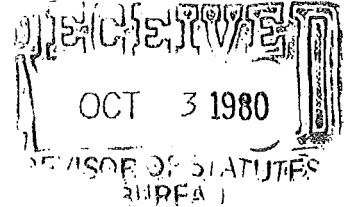

ORDER OF THE EDUCATIONAL APPROVAL BOARD

AMENDING RULES



- 1 Relating to rules concerning application and renewal fees required of
- 2 proprietary vocational schools and application and renewal fees re-
- 3 quired of applicants for solicitors' permits.

Analysis Prepared by the Educational Approval Board

These amendments revise the fee structures contained in Wis. Adm. Code section EAB 2.11, which interprets s. 38.51(10)(b), Wis. Stats., and section EAB 3.02, which interprets s. 38.51(8)(b), Wis. Stats.

Section EAB 2.11(1) is extensively revised to conform to s. 38.51(10)(b), Wis. Stats., which requires an application fee not only for schools, but also for courses of instruction offered by schools. The total amount of fees collected from schools applying for approval will increase. Increased revenues are needed to cover more of the costs associated with review, evaluation, and approval of schools. Even with the increases, only a portion of the costs will be offset by fees received.

The annual fee for renewal of school approval is raised to \$100. Renewal fees support the regulatory activities of the board, including investigation of complaints, regular inspection of schools, file maintenance, and preparation of responses to requests for information regarding approved schools. Increases in the costs of postage, travel, salaries, materials and supplies have made fee increases necessary to maintain positive balances in the fund supporting those activities.

The application fee for a school seeking approval under a change of ownership or control is raised to \$75. The costs of reviewing applications have increased for the same reasons as stated above.

The application fee for approval of a course of instruction not approved is raised to \$150. The increased fee still represents only a portion of the total cost of reviewing an application for approval of a course.

The application fee for a new solicitor's permit is raised to \$50, while the renewal fee is increased to \$30. Increases in postage, salaries, and materials have made these increases necessary.

3 interpreting s. 38.51(8)(b) and (10)(b), Wis. Stats., as follows:

6 EAB 2.11 Application and renewal fees. (s. 38.51(10)(b), Stats.)

7 (1) Application fees for initial school approval. A school which is not
8 ~~currently~~ approved by the board to operate or do business in ~~Wisconsin~~
9 the state and which is applying for such approval, shall pay fees ac-
10 ~~ording to the following schedule, based upon the number of courses of~~
11 ~~instruction for which the school is applying for approval to market in~~
12 ~~Wisconsin~~

- 1 ~~(a) -- One course of instruction -- -- \$150.~~
- 2 ~~(b) -- 2, 3, or 4 courses of instruction -- -- \$300.~~
- 3 ~~(c) -- 5, 6, 7, or 8 courses of instruction -- -- \$400.~~
- 4 ~~(d) -- Over 8 courses of instruction -- -- \$500.~~

5 a fee of \$100, plus a fee for each course of instruction the school
6 wishes to offer or advertise in the state, as provided in sub. (3).

7 (2) Annual fees for renewal of school approval. Each school
8 ~~currently approved by the board~~ to operate or do business in ~~Wisconsin~~
9 the state shall pay an annual fee of ~~\$50.~~ \$100., due on September 1 of
10 the year following the calendar year in which approval was initially
11 granted, and on September 1 of each year thereafter. Failure to pay re-
12 newal fees on or before the due date shall be sufficient grounds for
13 revocation of approval.

14 (3) Application fee for approval of ~~additional~~ courses of instruc-
15 tion. A school ~~currently approved to do business in Wisconsin~~ shall pay
16 an application fee of ~~\$400.~~ \$150. when applying for approval of a course
17 of instruction ~~not currently approved by the board.~~

18 (4) Effect of denial of approval. If the board denies approval to
19 a school or to one or more courses of instruction of a school, and an
20 appeal of the board's decision is not made or ~~if made,~~ is unsuccessful
21 if made, then the fees paid are not refundable, and appropriate fees as
22 provided in this section ~~EAB-2.11(4) or EAB-2.11(3)~~ shall be paid if the
23 school subsequently reapplies for approval.

24 (5) Waiver of fees. The board may in its sole discretion waive,
25 in whole or in part, fees otherwise payable by schools for reinstatement
26 of approval which has been revoked or has expired, if the board determines

1 ~~the~~ that a re-evaluation of the school's courses of instruction is un-
2 necessary.

3 (6) Change of ownership or control. Approval of a school terminates
4 at the time when the ownership or control of ~~said~~ the school changes from
5 that indicated on its most recent application filed with the board. An
6 approved school ~~must~~ shall notify the board of any proposed change of
7 ownership or control. An amended application reflecting ~~said~~ the change
8 of ownership or control shall be submitted to the board by the prospective
9 owner or owners prior to the effective date of the transfer and shall be
10 accompanied by a fee of \$75. A school may request an interpretation of
11 the board as to the application of this section to a contemplated change
12 of ownership or control. ~~A fee of \$50 shall be paid by any school seeking~~
13 ~~approval pursuant to the provisions of this section.~~

14 Section EAB 3.02 (title) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended
15 to read:

16 EAB 3.02 Application for permit. (s. 38.51(8)(b), Stats.)

17 Section EAB 3.02(1) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

18 (1) Original application. An application for a solicitor's permit
19 shall be made on forms furnished by the board ~~which must~~ and shall be
20 accompanied by a ~~\$40~~ \$50. fee and a surety bond acceptable to the board
21 in the sum of \$1,000.

22 Section EAB 3.02(2) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

23 (2) Renewal application. An application for renewal of a solicitor's
24 permit shall be made on forms furnished by the board ~~which must~~ and shall
25 be accompanied by a fee of ~~\$25~~ \$30. and a surety bond acceptable to the

- 1 board in the sum of \$1,000 if a continuous bond has not been furnished.
- 2 The amendments contained in this order shall take effect on the first
- 3 day of the month following publication in final form in the Wisconsin
- 4 Administrative Register.
