

Pursuant to s. 101.19 (1) (b), Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations proposes to repeal and recreate s. Ind 69.07 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code chapter Ind 69 - Fee Schedule to read as follows:

Ind 69.07 AMUSEMENT RIDES AND ATTRACTIONS. (1) Plan Examination, Data Review, Registration and Inspections. Fees for amusement rides and attractions shall be determined in accordance with the following schedule:

(a) Amusement Rides (see s. Ind 47.02 for definition).

Note: For the purpose of determining the correct classification of rides, the following definitions are provided from s. Ind 47.02.

CLASS I: Mild rides which do not lift passengers.

CLASS II: Thrill rides and mild rides which lift passengers and are accepted by the department based on 10 years of proven field service.

CLASS III: Thrill rides and mild rides which lift passengers and which have been designed and tested in accordance with recognized engineering principles.

CLASS IV: Rides which do not meet criteria of the above classes and which require load testing prior to operating.

5. Inspection of Class 2 and 3 amusement \$85.00/ride rides, except amusement rides that the manufacturer estimates require more than 40 manhours for erection.

6. Inspection of Class 4 amusement rides \$125.00/ride and amusement rides that the manufacturer estimates require more than 40 manhours for erection.

- Inspection of amusement ride tramways. \$150.00/tramway
 Late registration fee (failure to register amusement ride before opening it to the public).
 A reinspection fee shall be charged for each inspection after the first reinspection to gain compliance with department orders.
- (b) Amusement Attractions.
 - 1. Annual registration (see s. Ind 47.02 \$ 15.00/attr. for definition).
 - 2. Inspection. \$ 20.00/attr.
 - 3. Late registration fee (failure to reg- \$ 40.00/attr. ister amusement attraction before opening it to the public).
 - 4. Each additional attraction reinspection \$ 50.00/attr. required to obtain compliance with department orders subsequent to first reinspection.
- (2) Fee Assessment and Collection. (a) Registration and inspection fees for amusement rides and attractions shall be paid annually before registration is processed by the department.
 - (b) Additional reinspection fees in accordance with subs. (1) (a) 9. and (1) (b) 4. and late registration fees in accordance with (1) (a) 8. and (1) (b) 3. shall be assessed as necessary in addition to the annual registration and inspection fees.
 - (c) The fees specified in this section shall not be subject to fee adjustments specified in s. Ind 69.01 until June 30, 1982.
