### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The surface water of Blackhawk Lake has been regulated in the past by town ordinance. The ordinance in effect is a no-wake ordinance. The Department of Natural Resources is proposing a continuation of the no-wake regulation to help protect the shoreline of the lake and to help prevent further erosion of the clay blanket. Town officials have indicated the Department should enact surface water regulations on Blackhawk Lake since the State owns the lakebed and shoreline.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.091 and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules interpreting sections 23.091(3), Wisconsin Statutes, as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 45.09 (11) is created to read:

(11) No person may operate a motorboat of any kind in any manner except at a slow-no-wake speed and in no case at a speed to exceed 5 miles per hour on the waters of Blackhawk lake, sections 5 and 6, T6N, R2E, town of Highland and sections 7 and 8, T6N, R2E, town of Eden, Iowa county, Wisconsin.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 17, 1980.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication as provided in section 227.026(1) intro., Wisconsin Statutes.


