

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD RENUMBERING, REPEALING AND RECREATING, AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of renumbering s. NR 46.11; repealing and recreating s. NR 46.09(2)(a), (b) and (c); and creating ss. NR 46.10(1)(h) and NR 46.11 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to the Woodland Tax Law and stumpage values for severance tax under the Forest Crop Law

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The revisions to chapter NR 46, Wis. Adm. Code:

- 1. Create a provision to declassify a Woodland Tax Law contract and reenter the contract with additional acreage without a tax penalty for the owner;
- 2. Create an additional provision with criteria for entry of lands under the Woodland Tax Law. This provision previously existed in the code, but was inadvertently omitted when this section was created in February, 1980; and
- 3. Create annual stumpage values for the purpose of calculating severance tax due on timber cut from Forest Crop Law lands as of November 1, 1981 as required by ch. 77, Stats. There are five separate severance schedule zones to more accurately reflect varying stumpage prices for different species and products across the state. This makes it possible to levy severance taxes which more nearly represent 10% of the stumpage value which is the basic legislative intent.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 77.06(2), 77.16 and 227.014, Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby renumbers, repeals and recreates, and creates rules interpreting ss. 77.06(2) and 77.16, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 46.09(2)(a), and (b) and (c) are repealed and recreated to read:

(2) STUMPAGE VALUES FOR SEVERANCE TAX. Forest crop law severance schedule zones are established as designated on the following map entitled "Forest Crop Law Severance Schedule Zones" and the rates shall be as follows:

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SECTION 2 - Section NR 46.10(1)(h) is created to read:

(h) No more than 20% or less of the total contiguous proposed entry or renewal may consist of non-productive areas.

SECTION 3 - Section 46.11 is renumbered to be section NR 46.12.

SECTION 4 - Section NR 46.11 is created to read:

NR 46.11 Declassification is necessary to add acreage to an entry. A declassification penalty may not apply provided reapplication by the owner and approval for entry by the department is made concurrent with declassification. Areas of greater than 3 acres but less than 10 acres, if contiguous to an exiting entry and meeting all other requirements for entry, may be added to such entry.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on May 27, 1981.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.
