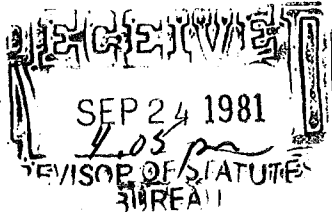

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That pursuant to authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board in ss. 15.08(5), 227.014 and Chapter 453, Stats., the Veterinary Examining Board hereby creates and adopts rules, interpreting ss. 15.08(5)(b) and 453.07, Stats., as follows:

Section VE 3.02(20) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

(20) Prescribing, ordering, dispensing, administering, supplying, selling or giving of any amphetamine, its salts, isomers and salts of its isomers or related sympathomimetic amine drug designated as a Schedule II drug in Ch. 161, Stats., except for the treatment of narcolepsy or hyperkinesis in animals who do not respond to other methods of treatment, or for clinical research of these compounds as approved by the board. A written description of the intended research project proposed shall be filed with the board prior to conducting the research.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
