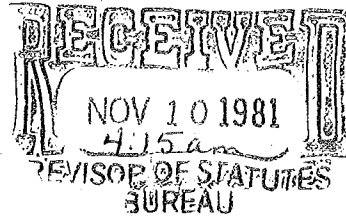



ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That pursuant to authority vested in the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors in ss. 15.08(5), 227.014 and Chapter 443, Stats., and pursuant to s. 227.02(1)(b), Stats., the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors hereby amend, without notice or hearing, rules in Chapters A-E 1 and 4 of the Wisconsin administrative code as follows:

Section 1. Section A-E 1.05 of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

1.05 FIRM AND PARTNERSHIP INFORMATION REPORTS. When it appears to the board that any person or persons are practicing or offering to practice architecture or professional engineering through a firm or partnership, they shall, upon request, file with the board, on forms provided by the board, a list of the names and addresses of the members of said firm or partnership and a list of the names and addresses of all individuals who are registered architects or professional engineers in this state authorized to practice or offer to practice architecture or professional engineering on behalf of said firm or partnership, and any other information requested by the board which may be necessary to enable the board to determine whether or not such firm or partnership complies with the provisions of s. ~~443-01~~, 443.08, Stats.

Section 2. Section A-E 1.12(1) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(1) For the purpose of meeting experience requirements for registration as an architect, an applicant may claim certain education as equivalent to experience in architecture, as provided in s. ~~443-01(6)(a)~~ 443.03(2), Stats. To qualify as an education equivalent to architectural experience, such education ~~must~~ shall be obtained at a university, college or technical school approved by the architects' section of the examining board.

Section 3. Section A-E 1.13(1) and (2) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(1) To qualify as satisfactory experience in architectural work for the purpose of meeting registration requirements of s. ~~443.01(6)(a)~~ 443.03(1), Stats. such experience shall include the application of architectural principles and data and shall demonstrate applicant's progressive development of competence to do architectural work.

(2) Satisfactory work experience shall consist of related practical training including at least one year of experience in the design and construction of buildings preferably under the supervision of a then registered architect, professional engineer, or exempt person as defined in s. ~~443.01(9)~~ 443.14, Stats. prior or subsequent to acquisition of approved educational equivalents.

Section 4. Section A-E 1.15(4)(a) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(a) EXAMINATION REQUIRED. All applicants for registration as architects, except those applying under s. ~~443.01(11)~~ 443.10(1), Stats. ~~must~~ shall complete an examination consisting of sections covering: Architectural Sciences and Technology (Structure, Construction, Environmental Control), Architectural Design, Project Development, Professional Administration, and Historical and Theoretical Context.

Section 5. Section A-E 1.15(7)(e) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(e) REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRANCE TO EXAMINATIONS. 1. To be eligible to enter a written examination for a permit as a designer of engineering systems, an applicant ~~must~~ shall have 7 years of approved experience in specialized engineering design work, up to 4 years of which may be equivalent academic training or apprenticeship as provided in s. ~~443.01(16)~~ ~~(a)~~ 3, 443.07(2), Stats.

Section 6. Section A-E 1.16(1) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(1) For the purpose of meeting experience requirements for registration as a professional engineer, an applicant may claim certain education as equivalent to experience in engineering as provided in s. ~~443.01(6)(b)~~ 443.04(2), Stats. The engineers' section grants an experience equivalent for education according to the table shown in sub. (2).

Section 7. Section A-E 1.18 of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

1.18 EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR LAND SURVEYORS. To meet the educational requirements of s. ~~443.02(3)(a)~~ 443.06(2)(a), Stats., requiring ". . . a course in land surveying of not less than 2 years duration approved by the section . . ." an applicant for registration as a land surveyor ~~must~~ shall have satisfactorily completed at least 60 semester credits in a civil engineering or land surveying curriculum including no less than 12 semester credits in land surveying which shall be in the following categories of study:

Section 8. Section A-E 1.19(6) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(6) Experience in areas of work relating to land surveying such as those described in sections A-E 1.18(2) and 1.70(5) providing that the applicant has at least one-half of the experience required for registration in areas of land surveying defined in s. ~~443.02(1)(b)~~ 443.01(8), Stats., such as areas described in ~~subsections~~ subs. (1) through (5) above and ~~section s.~~ A-E 1.70(1) through (4).

Section 9. Section A-E 1.20(4) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(4) Designers are restricted to performing such design services, as defined in sections A-E 1.001(2) of these rules, in those fields in which they hold a permit, except as those services are exempted by ss. ~~443.01(1)(d)~~, ~~443.01(9)~~ and ~~443.01(10)~~; 443.14 and 443.15, Stats.

Section 10. Section A-E 1.70 of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

1.70 EXAMPLES OF LAND SURVEYING SERVICES. The term "land surveying" is defined in s. ~~443.02(1)(b)~~ 443.01(8), Stats. Specific examples of land surveying services within the statutory definition are set forth below. Examples of services not within the definition are listed in sub. (5).

Section 11. Section A-E 4.002(3) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(3) The examining board shall determine what acts constitute violation of the rules and shall institute appropriate disciplinary action which may lead to the revocation of the registration, permit, or certificate of the architect, professional engineer, designer, land surveyor, or corporation, in accordance with ~~sections 443.10 (13)~~, ~~443.10 (16)~~, and ~~443.02 (8)~~; Wis. ss. 443.11, 443.12 and 443.13, Stats.


Section 12. Section A-E 4.004(1) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(1) The term "responsible supervision of construction" has the meaning prescribed in ~~section 443.01 (2) (g)~~; Wis. s. 443.01(7), Stats.

The rule amendments and adoption contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
