

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 20.03(1)(q)2.

of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relating
to lake sturgeon spearing on the upriver waters,
Winnebago County

F-52-81

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

For management purposes, the lake sturgeon spearing season on the upriver waters of Winnebago County is limited to an open season once every five years. This management program was initiated in 1973 following a public hearing. To be consistent with this management program and to enhance the lake sturgeon populations in these upriver waters, the code must be changed to close the season in 1982.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.174 and 227.014, Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting s. 29.174, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1 - NR 20.03 (1) (q) 2. is amended to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (in.)
 Lakes Butte des Morts, Poygan and Winneconne and connecting waters 	February-21-and 22 No open season	i-pe≠ season	45

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 18, 1981.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on February 1, 1982.
