ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That, pursuant to authority vested in the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors in ss. 15.08(5), 227.014 and Chapter 443, Stats., the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors hereby amends and adopts rules, interpreting s. 443.03, Stats., as follows:

Section A-E 1.13(5) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(5) INTERN ARCHITECT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM RECORD. An applicant who has participated in the intern architect development program sponsored by the national council of architectural registration boards and the American Institute of Architects may submit a record of participation in the program as evidence of architectural experience. The architects section shall evaluate the record of participation and grant appropriate experience credit.

The rule amendment contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
