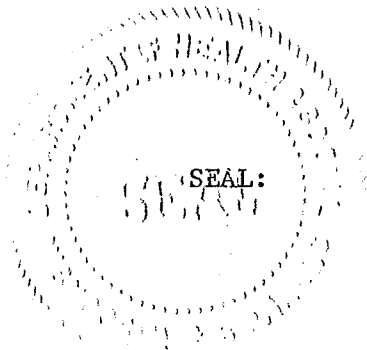

ORDER OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES
REPEALING, RENUMBERING AND AMENDING RULESRevisor of Statutes
Bureau

To repeal H 53.01(5) and H 53.06, to renumber H 53, to renumber HSS 153.01(6) to (12), and to amend HSS 153.01(10), as renumbered, relating to home care of hemophilia.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Health and Social Services

This order removes from ch. H 53, Wis. Adm. Code, all references to the Council on Hemophilia and Related Bleeding Disorders, which was abolished as of April 8, 1981, under a sunset provision of Chapter 213 of the Laws of 1977. The order also renumbers the rules chapter to bring it into the HSS series within the Wisconsin Administrative Code. Eventually all chapters of rules administered by the Department will be grouped together in the multi-volume Code, and will be further grouped within the HSS series either by broad program (Community Services, Health, Economic Assistance, Vocational Rehabilitation, Corrections) or by Department-level function (Uniform Fees, Administrative Hearings, Parole Board, etc.). It will then become easier for interested persons to identify and locate rules administered by the Department.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services by s. 49.485(4), (6) and (8), Stats., the Department of Health and Social Services hereby repeals, renumbers, and amends rules interpreting s. 49.485, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. H 53.01(5) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

SECTION 2. H 53.06 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

SECTION 3. H 53 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is renumbered HSS 153.

SECTION 4. HSS 153.01(6) to (12) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are renumbered HSS 153.01 (5) to (11).

SECTION 5. HSS 153.01(10) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:


- (10) "Physician director" means the medical director of a comprehensive hemophilia treatment center who is directly responsible for an individual's maintenance program. The physician director must be a physician licensed in Wisconsin, certified by the American board of internal medicine or American board of pediatrics or equivalent certifying body, with specialized training in hematology, as determined by the department ~~upon recommendation of the council.~~

The rule amendment, repeals, and renumbering contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.026(1), Stats.

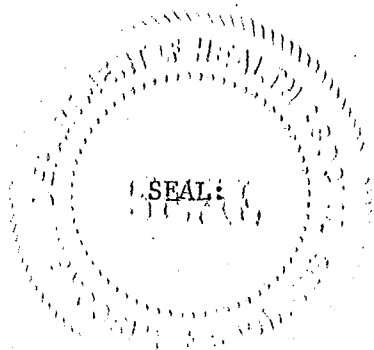
