19 inspection and certification under s. Ag 23.07 shall be \$7 \$12 for

22 ~~required-except-for-the-making-of-the-special-inspection;-or-if~~
23 ~~less-than-one-half-hour;-a-minimum-fee-of-\$2-shall-be-charged:~~
24 ~~There-shall-be-a-maximum-charge-of-\$50-per-day-plus-travel-costs.~~
25 Additional charges shall be assessed to cover actual expenses for
26 vehicle mileage, meals and lodging made necessary by the
27 inspection.

1 (2) In addition to any other fees under this section, there
2 shall be a processing fee of \$5 for each phytosanitary certificate
3 or plant health certificate issued by the department pursuant to
4 s. Ag 23.07.

5 ~~(2)~~ (3) Wherever possible, ~~the-making-of~~ special inspections
6 shall be integrated with other routine or regularly scheduled
7 inspections at the convenience of the department.

8 ~~(3)~~ (4) Inspection fees are payable to the department and
9 collectible by court action as a claim of the state. Delinquent
10 payments shall be grounds for cancellation of further inspection
11 service and certification.

12 The amendments contained in this order shall take effect on
13 the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin
14 Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.026(1), Stats.
