ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
REPEALING, AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 10.01(1)(1)3.c. to f.;
amending s. NR 10.01(1)(1)2.(intro.), (2)(e)1.b.,
(4)(c) 1.a., 2.a. & 3.a; and creating s. NR 19.26 of the

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The revisions contained in this order pertain to Canada goose permit application procedures, quail bag limits, beaver seasons, and the use of dynamite for beaver dam removal. More specifically, the revisions will:

1. Clarify the priority treatment of Canada goose permit applications and eliminate the need for notifying unsuccessful applicants. The rule modification clearly establishes September 10 as the deadline for priority applicants. Because recording of applicants is accomplished by computer enabling cross checking to occur, mailings to unsuccessful applicants can be eliminated.
2. Liberalize quail bag limits. The rule increases the daily bag limit for quail from 2 to 5 and the possession limit from 4 to 10. Increased bag limits will enable hunters to take advantage of high population levels of this game bird.
3. Eliminate the closed season between "regular" and "special" beaver seasons. This rule would produce a continuous beaver season statewide on certain waters. Because trapper surveys and registration provides adequate information on the effectiveness of regular and special seasons, a closure requiring trappers to pull their traps from watersets and to reset later is unnecessary.
4. Clarify the use of dynamite for beaver dam removal. This rule allows individuals authorized by DNR permit to remove beaver dams with dynamite. A lack of clarification on this rule hampers prompt dam removal and increases removal costs and property damages.

Board hereby repeals, amends and creates rules interpreting ss. 29.01(5), 29.085, 29.09(1), 29.174, 29.59 and 29.60, Stats., as follows:

Section 1. NR 10.01(1)(1)2.(intro.) is amended to read:

2. 'Permit applications procedures'. Application forms supplied by the department shall be completed and submitted by the applicant. Applications must be received by the department no later than September ~~30~~ 10 of each year.

Section 2. NR 10.01(1)(1) 3.c. to f. are repealed.

Section 3. NR 10.01(2)(e)1.b. is amended to read:

SECTION 7. NR 19.26 is created to read:

NR 19.26 BEAVER DAM REMOVAL (s. 29.29, 29.60, Stats.). Explosives, including dynamite, may be used to remove beaver dams provided a permit is issued by the department to remove the structure by such means.
