SECTION 1. Ind 69.07 (1) ~~is~~ repealed and recreated to read:

Ind 69.07 AMUSEMENT RIDES AND ATTRACTIONS. (1) PLAN EXAMINATION, DATA REVIEW, REGISTRATION AND INSPECTIONS. Fees for amusement rides and attractions shall be determined in accordance with the following schedule:

(a) Amusement rides (see Ind 47.02 for definition).

- 1. Plan examination for new amusement ride tramways (see s. Ind 46.02 for definition) \$135.00 per plan submittal
- 2. Review of engineering analysis and test data associated with the acceptance of Class 3 and 4 rides \$135.00 per review
- 3. Annual registration for all amusement rides (see s. Ind 47.03) \$ 35.00 per ride
- 4. Inspection of Class 1 amusement rides . . \$ 54.00 per ride
- 5. Inspection of Class 2 and 3 amusement rides, except amusement rides that the manufacturer estimates require more than 40 work hours for erection \$116.00 per ride
- 6. Inspection of Class 4 amusement rides and amusement rides that the manufacturer estimates require more than 40 work hours for erection \$169.00 per ride
- 7. Inspection of amusement ride tramways . . \$203.00 per tramway
- 8. Late registration fee (failure to register amusement ride before opening it to the public) \$ 89.00 per ride
- 9. Reinspection fee for each inspection after the first reinspection to gain compliance with department orders \$135.00

Note: For the purpose of determining the correct classification of rides, the following definitions are provided from s. Ind 47.04:

- CLASS 1: Mild rides which do not lift passengers.
- CLASS 2: Thrill rides and mild rides which lift passengers and are accepted by the department based on 10 years of proven field service.
- CLASS 3: Thrill rides and mild rides which lift passengers and which have been designed and tested in accordance with recognized engineering principles.
- CLASS 4: Rides which do not meet criteria of the above classes and which require load testing prior to operating.

SECTION 2. Ind 69.07 (1) (b) 4. is repealed.

SECTION 3. Ind 69.07 (2) is repealed and recreated to read:

Ind 69.07 (2) FEE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION. Registration and inspection fees for amusement rides and attractions shall be paid annually before registration is processed by the department.
