ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING, AND REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending ss. NR 10.01(2)(a) .
and (b) and (3)(c)3.; repealing and recreating .
s. NR 10.01(2)(d) and (e) and (3)(q) of the . G-46-82
Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to .
1983 hunting and trapping regulations .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The following changes are being made in the 1983 hunting and trapping regulations:

1. The opening date for ruffed grouse hunting is moved up two weeks to the Saturday nearest September 15. The ruffed grouse season in Waukesha County is opened.
2. The seasons for quail, Hungarian partridge and bear (with firearms) are expanded to statewide seasons.
3. The jackrabbit season closure in Clark, Lincoln, Marathon, Taylor and Wood Counties is eliminated.
4. The sharp-tailed grouse season is closed in Langlade, Marinette and Florence Counties experimentally for five years.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174(1) and (2), 227.014 and 227.022(3), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends, and repeals and recreates rules interpreting ss. 29.085 and 29.174(1) and (2), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 10.01(2)(a) and (b) are amended to read:

<u>(a) Ruffed grouse (partridge)</u>		
1. All that part of Wisconsin lying south of a line beginning at the junction of state highway 64 and the west boundary of St. Croix county, then east on highway 64 to its intersection with U.S. highway 45, then southeasterly on highway 45 to its intersection with U.S. highway 10, then east on highway 10 and continuing east to the junction with the east boundary of the state.	Beginning on the Saturday nearest October 1 <u>September 15</u> and continuing through January 31	Daily bag 5; possession 10
2. Remainder of the state except Waukesha county	Beginning on the Saturday nearest October 1 <u>September 15</u> and continuing through December 31	5 each day; <u>Daily bag 5;</u> 10 possession <u>10</u>
3. Waukesha county	None	None
<u>(b) Sharp-tailed grouse</u>		
1. All that part of Wisconsin lying northerly north of a line beginning at the junction of state highway 64 and the west boundary of the state, then easterly east along highway 64 to its junction with state highway 13 then southerly south along highway 13 to its junction with state highway 29, then easterly east along highway 29 ending in the city of Green Bay except Florence, Langlade, and Marinette counties through 1987	Beginning on the Saturday nearest October 15 and continuing for 23 consecutive days	Daily bag 3; possession <u>6</u>
2. In all other parts <u>Remainder</u> of the state	None	None

SECTION 2. NR 10.01(2)(d) and (e) are repealed and recreated to read:

Kind of animal and locality	Open season (all dates inclusive)	Limit
(d) <u>Hungarian partridge</u> In all counties of the state	Beginning on the Saturday nearest October 27 at 12:00 noon and continuing for 44 consecutive days.	Daily bag 3; possession 6
(e) <u>Bobwhite quail</u> In all counties of the state	Beginning on Saturday nearest October 27 at 12:00 noon and continuing for 44 consecutive days	Daily bag 5; possession 10

SECTION 3. NR 10.01(3)(c)3. is amended to read:

Kind of animal and locality	Open season (all dates inclusive)	Limit
3. Jackrabbit in all counties of the state, except Clark, Lincoln, Marathon, Taylor and Wood counties	Beginning on the Saturday nearest October 1 and continuing through October 31.	3-each-day;-6 Daily bag 3; possession 6

SECTION 4. NR 10.01(3)(g) is repealed and recreated to read:

Kind of animal and locality	Open season (all dates inclusive)	Limit
(g) Bear		
1. Firearm season. In all counties of the state	Beginning on the 2nd Saturday in September and continuing for 16 consecutive days	
2. Bow and arrow season		
a. All that part of the state north of state highway 29	Beginning on the 2nd Saturday in September and continuing through the Sunday immediately prior to the opening of the gun deer season	
b. Remainder of the state	Beginning on the 3rd Saturday in September and continuing through the Sunday immediately prior to the opening of the gun deer season	One adult bear per season with bow and arrow or firearm

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 17, 1982.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.,
