ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING, RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING, AND CREATING RULES

In THE MATTER OF repealing ss. NR 10.01(3)(e)5. and 8.,. 10.11 and 10.20(1)(b)1.; renumbering ss NR 10.11(2), 10.20(1)(a), (b)2. and (2), 10.201 and 10.21; amending ss. NR 10.01(3)(e)4. (intro.), 10.02(1), 10.15(5)(a), 11.01(2)(a) (intro.), 16.02(4)(a) through (f) and 19.09(2m)(c); repealing and recreating s. NR 10.01(3) (h)1.; and creating ss. NR 10.001(25), 10.09(1)(c) (title), 2. and 3. and (3), 10.10(2)(title), 10.102, 10.104(title), (1)(title) and (b) and 10.12(5)(title) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to regulation modification for the 1983 hunting and trapping seasons.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The changes proposed in this order are intended to clarify, recodify and correct existing hunting and trapping regulations for the 1983 hunting and trapping seasons. The major changes are:

- 1. Clarification of the definition of "liquid" associated with liquid scent baiting. The current definition is too open to interpretation and causes confusion. The proposed definition is more concise.
- 2. Creation of uniform tagging instructions for archery and gun deer hunting. A no-tear paper product has been used experimentally for achery deer carcass tags for the past 3 years. The new material is superior to metal tags.
- 3. Update of assessment fees for game farms consistent with s. 29.65, Stats. The fees are assessed for animals on game farm lands at the time of licensing.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.02(1), 29.174(1), 29.40(1), 29.544(2), 29.65(1), 227.014(2)(a) and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals, renumbers, amends, repeals and recreates, and creates rules interpreting ss. 29.085, 29.174, 29.574(3) and 29.544, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 10.001(25) is created to read:

(25) "Liquid" means a substance, neither solid or gaseous, that flows freely and takes the shape of its container at a temperature of 70°F.

SECTION 2. NR 10.01(3)(e)4. (intro.) is amended to read:

4. Zone "D"

The counties of Dane (east of state highway 78 and south of U.S. highway 18), Dodge (south of state highway 60), Jefferson, Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee (south of state highway 60 and county highway Q), Racine, Rock, Walworth, Washington (south of state highway 60) and Waukesha.

SECTION 3. NR 10.01(3)(e)5. and 8. are repealed.

SECTION 4. NR 10.01(3)(h)1. is repealed and recreated to read:

1.	'Hunting'. In all counties	All year	None

SECTION 5. NR 10.02(1) is amended to read:

(1) Ganada-lynx, timber welf, <u>Cougar</u>, badger, moose, elk, marten, fisher, wolverine and flying squirrel.

SECTION 6. NR 10.09(1)(c) (title) is amended to read:

(c) Guns and devices.

SECTION 7. NR 10.09(1)(c) 2. and 3. are created to read:

- 2. 'Deer or bear hunting.' Hunt any deer or bear with any .22 rim-fire rifle, 5 mm rim-fire rifle, .17 caliber center-fire rifle or .410 bore shotgun.
- 3. 'Possession.' Possess any rifle larger than .22 rim-fire in areas wherein there is an open season for hunting deer with shotgun only unless such rifle is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case.

SECTION 8. NR 10.09(3) is created to read:

- (3) BOW AND ARROWS. No person may: (a) <u>Possession of strung bow.</u>

 Possess a bow while in, on, or traversing areas inhabited by deer during the open season for hunting deer from one-half hour after the close of hunting hours established in s. NR 10.06(3) to one-half hour before opening of hunting hours unless such bow is unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case.
- (b) <u>Special restrictions</u>. Use, possess or have under control while hunting, any poisoned or drugged arrow, arrow with explosive tips or any crossbow.
- (c) <u>Arrow standards.</u> Use, possess or have under control while deer or bear hunting, any arrow with a metal broad-head blade less than seven-eighths of an inch in width. Such broad-head blades must be well-sharpened.
- (d) <u>Bow size.</u> Hunt deer or bear with a bow having a pull of less than 30 pounds.

SECTION 9. NR 10.102 is created to read:

NR 10.102 DEER HUNTING. (1) TAGS. A one-piece back and carcass tag shall be issued with each hunting license and shall remain intact until the hunter kills a deer. Any person who kills a deer shall:

- (a) <u>Validation</u>. Immediately separate the issued carcass tag from the back tag and validate the carcass tag by slitting the mark designating the month, day, time of kill and type of deer. Failure to completely validate the carcass tag renders possession of the deer illegal and the carcass tag invalid.
- (b) Attachment. Immediately upon validation and before the deer is carried by hand or transported in any manner, the hunter shall attach the issued carcass tag to the gambrel of either hind leg of the deer.

SECTION 10. NR 10.104 (title), (1)(title) and NR 10.104(1)(b) are created to read:

NR 10.104 RECORDING DEER AND BEAR. (1) GUN SEASONS.

- (b) <u>Registration tagging</u>. Upon verification of license information, the station operator shall attach and lock a registration tag to the bear or part thereof. For deer, the operator shall:
- 1. Complete and retain the registration portion of the hunter's license; and
- 2. Attach and lock a registration tag to the deer or part thereof through the carcass tag.

SECTION 11. NR 10.11(2) is renumbered 10.10(2) and (2) (title) is created to read:

(2) ILLEGAL GAME.

SECTION 12. NR 10.11(1) and (3) to (5) are repealed.

SECTION 13. NR 10.12(5) (title) is amended to read:

(5) TAKING METHODS.

SECTION 14. NR 10.15(5)(a) is amended to read:

(a) With the written approval of the department, an open season may be declared for trapping muskrat; -mink-and-raceoon fur bearing animals.

SECTION 15. NR 10.20(1)(a) is renumbered NR 10.104(1)(a).

SECTION 16. NR 10.20(1)(b)1. is repealed.

SECTION 17. NR 10.20(1)(b)2. and (2) are renumbered NR 10.104(1)(a)6. and (2).

SECTION 18. NR 10.201 is renumbered NR 10.145.

SECTION 19. NR 10.21 is renumbered NR 10.08.

SECTION 20. NR 11.01(2)(a) (intro.) is amended to read:

(a) Rock county goose area. Township 2 north, range 14 east, town of Bradford and township 3 north, range 14 east, town of Johnstown.

SECTION 21. NR 16.02(4)(a) through (f) is amended to read:

- (a) Any wild turkey or bear, \$100 \$175
- (b) Any fox or bobcat, \$50 \$87.50
- (c) Any coyote, \$25 \$43.75
- (d) Any sharptail sharp-tailed grouse, or ruffed grouse, \$15 \$26.25
- (e) Any pheasant, Hungarian partridge, or quail, opossum or weasel, \$10.50
 - (f) Any rabbit, or squirrel, epessum-er-weasel, \$5 \$8.75

SECTION 22. NR 19.09(2m)(c) is amended to read:

(c) <u>Burnett county</u>. Bashaw lake, Big Clam lake, Briggs lake, Gaslyn lake, Long lake, <u>Leen-lake</u> <u>Mud lake</u>, town of Oakland, <u>Mud lake</u>, town of Swiss and Mud Hen lake, and Rice-lake.
