# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending ss. NR 20.02(1)(c), 20.03(1)(k), 25.06(2)(b)1. and 25.07(2)(b)5. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to commercial and sport fishing for yellow perch in outlying waters.

#### Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The amending of ss. NR 20.02(1)(c) and 20.03(1)(k), Wis. Adm. Code, revokes the special 25 fish daily sport fishing bag limit for yellow perch on Green Bay and Green Bay tributary streams. This makes the sport fishing daily bag limit 50 yellow perch on Green Bay, and 50 in aggregate with other specific panfish on streams tributary to Green Bay, effective January 1, 1985.

The amendment to s. NR 25.06(2)(b)1., Wis. Adm. Code, increases the total allowable commercial harvest of yellow perch in Green Bay from 200,000 pounds to 350,000 pounds for the 1984-85 license year.

The amendment to s. NR 25.07(2)(b)5., Wis. Adm. Code, changes the level of catch needed for the Department to inform the permittee that they are nearing the end of their quota from 90% to 75%. This will allow for a more timely notice.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174, 29.33 and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting ss. 29.085, 29.174 and 29.33, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 20.02(1)(c) is amended to read:

SECTION 3. NR 25.06(2)(b)1. is amended to read:

NR 25.06(2)(b)1. The total allowable commercial harvest in Green Bay for any license year may not exceed  $290_3000$  pounds.

SECTION 4. NR 25.07(2)(b)5. is amended to read:

NR 25.07(2)(b)5. Based on the information received in the weekly fishing reports, the department shall notify individual permittees when 90% 75% of their catch quota, as allocated under subd. 2., has been harvested.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on February 22, 1984.

Sections 3 and 4 of this order shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats. Sections 1 and 2 of this order shall take effect on January 1, 1985.
