ORDER OF THE  
STATE OF WISCONSIN

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, TRADE AND CONSUMER PROTECTION  
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

To repeal Ag 20.09(4); to renumber Ag 20.09(3); to amend Ag 20.09 (intro.), (1) and (2), and Ag 20.09(6)(a); and to create Ag 20.09(3); relating to fees for testing agricultural and vegetable seed samples.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Agriculture,  
Trade and Consumer Protection

The department's amendments to s. Ag 20.09, Wis. Adm. Code, will increase the fees charged by the department for testing agricultural and vegetable seed samples. The increases over the present fees, which have been in effect since January, 1981, represent an average increase of 22 percent.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection by ss. 93.07(1) and 94.45(3), Stats., the department repeals, amends and creates rules interpreting s. 94.45, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1: Ag 20.09 (intro.), (1) and (2) are amended to read:

Ag 20.09 (intro.) The fees for testing seed samples submitted to the state seed laboratory are based on costs of time and materials and are as set forth in this section. Except as otherwise described, the 3 basic tests consist of the purity analysis, the noxious weed seed examination and the germination test. The fees for the various types and categories of seeds and seed tests, and the sizes of samples needed for testing, are as follows:
