Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The rule repeals the trout and salmon snagging season on all Sheboygan county streams tributary to Lake Michigan upstream to the first dam and the Lake Michigan shoreline while fishing from shore in Sheboygan county. The rule change is in response to petitions from Sheboygan county, the city of Sheboygan and the village of Kohler which support a ban on snagging. The rule change is not required on biological grounds, but rather implements the position of the petitioners, who are ethically opposed to the snagging of trout and salmon.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174(2)(a) and (3) and 227.014(2), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals rules interpreting ss. 23.09(2)(intro.), 29.085, and 29.174(2)(a) and (3), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 20.04(3)(d)2.i. is repealed.
