IN THE MATTER OF THE RULEMAKING : ORDER OF THE CHIROPRACTIC
PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE : EXAMINING BOARD REPEALING,
CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINING BOARD : AMENDING OR ADOPTING RULES

AN ORDER to amend Chir 2.02(4), relating to examination requirements.

Analysis prepared by the department of regulation and licensing.

ANALYSIS

Currently, the provision in s. Chir 2.02(4) does not indicate from which chiropractic colleges the chiropractic examining board will accept certified transcripts to qualify applicants for examination for license to practice.

In this order, s. Chir. 2.02(4), interpreting s. 446.02(2), Stats., is amended to specify that the certified transcript that an applicant must provide to qualify for examination must be a transcript from a chiropractic college which has recognized candidate status for accreditation or accredited status with the commission on accreditation of the council of chiropractic education or any other specialized accrediting agency recognized by the United States department of education and the council on post-secondary accreditation.

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the chiropractic examining board in ss. 15.08(5)(b), 227.014(2)(a) and 446.02(2), the chiropractic examining board hereby amends and adopts rules, interpreting s. 446.02(2), Stats., as follows:


SECTION 1. Chir 2.02(4) is amended to read:

Chir 2.02(4) A certified transcript from an approved a chiropractic college as specified in s. 446.02(2), Stats. which has recognized candidate status for accreditation or accredited status with the commission on accreditation of the council on chiropractic education or any other specialized accrediting agency recognized by the United States department of education and the council on post-secondary accreditation.

The rules amended and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
