Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: 77.91(1) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.
Statutes interpreted: 77.06(2) and 77.91(1), Stats.

For the purposes of the forest crop law and managed forest law, this rule repeals and recreates s. NR 46.30(2) to revise annual stumpage values used to calculate severance and yield tax due on timber cut as of November 1, 1988 from lands entered as forest cropland or designated as managed forest lands as required by ss. 77.06(2) and 77.91(1), Stats.

One additional stumpage value zone is proposed, making 13 in all, to reflect stumpage value differences within the present Green Bay Zone 2. The 13 separate zones are to reflect varying stumpage prices for different species and products across the state. This zoning will result in severance and yield taxes which more nearly represent 10% and 5% of the actual stumpage value.

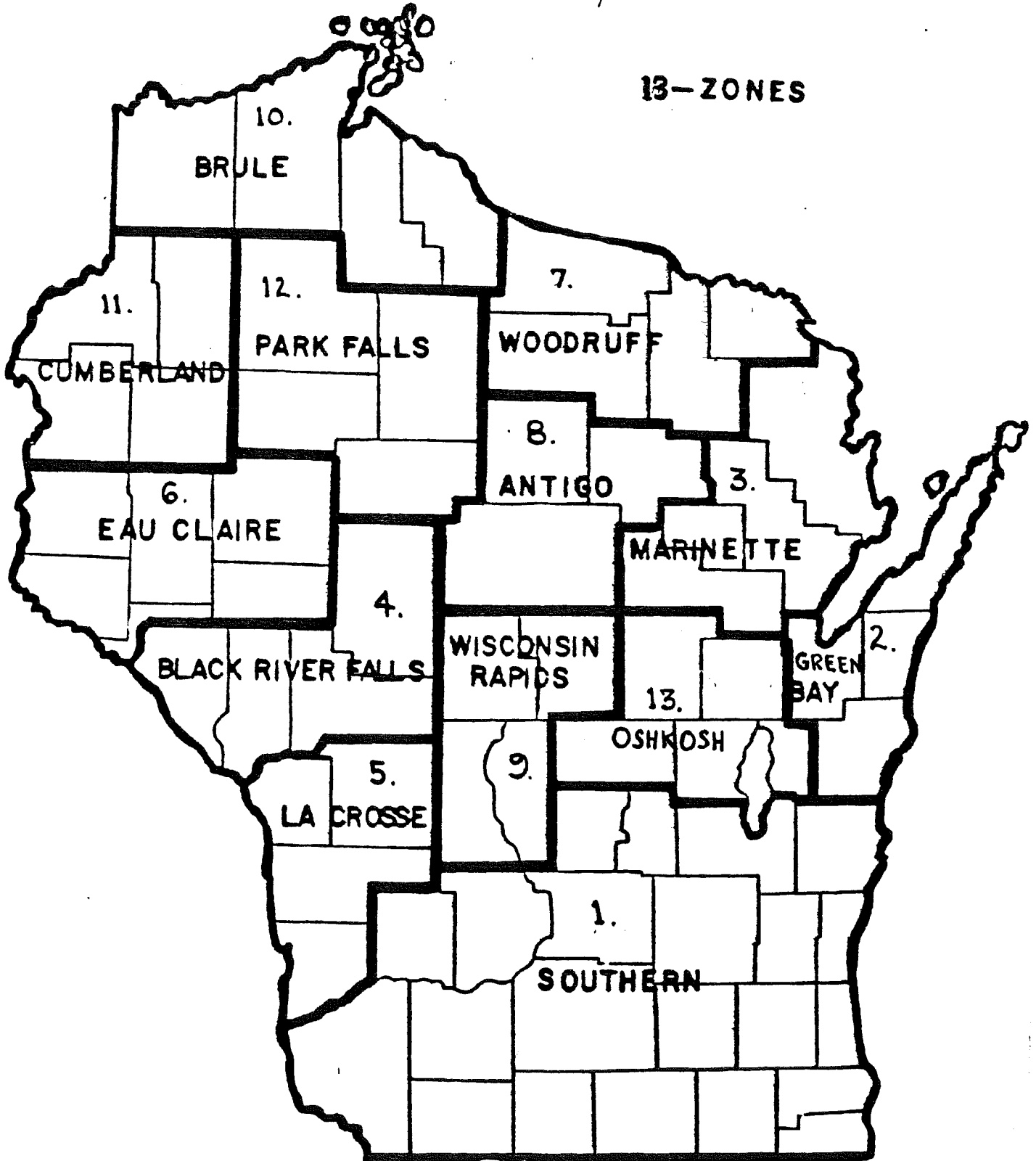

The rules contained herein shall take effect on November 1, 1988.

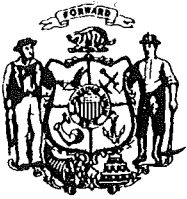


