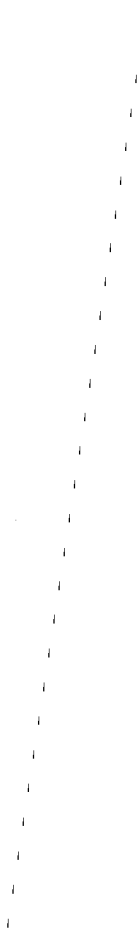

ORDER

An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to create Chir 2.025; and to amend Chir 2.02 (Title) and (4), relating to approved schools of chiropractic and incomplete applications.

ANALYSIS

Statutory authority: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) (a), 446.02 (2), Stats.

In this order, the Chiropractic Examining Board:

(1) Changes the title of section Chir 2.02 to better describe the subject matter of the rule.

(2) Amends its rule on approved school accrediting agencies to eliminate specialized accrediting agencies other than the council on chiropractic education.

(3) Creates a rule requiring that applications be completed within one year and that applicants take an examination within one year of completing an application.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 2.02 (Title) and (4) are amended to read:

Chir 2.02 (Title) APPLICATIONS.

(4) A certified transcript from a chiropractic college which has recognized candidate status for accreditation or accredited status with the commission on accreditation of the council on chiropractic education-~~or any other specialized accrediting agency recognized by the United States department of education and the council on post-secondary accreditation.~~

SECTION 2. Chir 2.025 is created to read:

Chir 2.025 TIME FOR COMPLETING APPLICATIONS AND TAKING EXAMINATION. An application is incomplete until all materials described in s. Chir 2.02 are filed with the board. All application materials described in s. Chir 2.02 shall be filed with the board within one year from the date the first item is filed. If an application is incomplete for more than one year, or if an applicant fails to take an examination within one year from the date the application is complete, all application materials shall be returned to the applicant by the department and the applicant shall begin the application process anew in order to take the examination for a license as a chiropractor.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22(2)(intro), Stats.
