ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 20.03(1)(c)2. c. and (d)4.c. and amending s. NR 20.03(1)(a)7. c. Wisconsin Administrative Code, pertaining to . FM-62-89 angling for largemouth bass, walleyes and northern pike on Round Lake, Waushara County.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3), 227.11(2)(a) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The rule sets an angling season from the first Saturday in May to March 1 on largemouth bass, walleyes and northern pike in Round Lake, Waushara County. It also establishes a daily bag limit of 0 fish for largemouth bass for two years, after which the bag limit reverts to the statewide bag limit of 5.

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(a)7.c. is amended to read:

Open season (both Daily bag length Kind of fish and locality dates inclusive) limit (inches)

C. Round lake (sec. 25, T20N, No open season

R11E), Waushara county First Saturday None may (largemouth bass) in May to March 1 be kept March 1

SECTION 2. NR 20.03(1)(c)2.c. and (d)4.c. are repealed.
