IN THE MATTER OF renumbering s. NR 20.03(1)(c)7.;. amending s. NR 20.03 (1)(c)3. and (d)5.; and FM-75-89 creating s. NR 20.03(1)(c)7. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to sport fishing

- Extends the special Lake Mendota regulations to the 1. following tributary waters: Cherokee Lake; Warner Park Lagoons; Pheasant Branch Creek from its mouth upstream to Dane County Hwy. M; Sixmile Creek from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19 in Sec. 8; and Yahara River from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19. The special regulations include a 15 inch minimum size limit on walleyes, a bag limit of 3 walleyes and a minimum size limit of 32 inches and a bag limit of one fish on northern pike.
- 2. Increases the minimum size limit on walleyes from 15 to 18 inches beginning on the first Saturday in May 1991 in Lake Mendota and the following tributary waters: Cherokee Lake; Warner Park Lagoons; Pheasant Branch Creek from its mouth upstream to Dane County Hwy. M; Sixmile Creek from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19 in Sec. 8; and Yahara River from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19.
