IN THE MATTER OF creating ss. NR 20.03(1)(a)1.e. FM-76-89 and f. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code . pertaining to sport fishing.

The Order:

- Increases the size limit from 12 to 18 inches and reduces the bag limit from 5 to 1 on largemouth and smallmouth bass on Cochran Lake, Price County; Lake Three, Ashland County; Crooked and Lund lakes, Bayfield County and Evelyn and One Man lakes, Iron County.
- Increases the size limit from 12 to 15 inches and reduces the bag limit from 5 to 2 on largemouth and smallmouth bass on the Gile Flowage, Iron County.

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(a)1.e. and f. are created to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (inches)	
e. Lake Three, Ashland county; Crooked and Lund lakes, Bayfield county; Evelyn and One Man lakes, Iron county; and Cochran Lake, Price county	First Saturday in May to March 1	1	18	
f. Gile flowage, Iron county	First Saturday in May to March 1	2	15
