IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating . s. NR 10.01(4)(c) and creating s. NR 10.35. of the Wisconsin administrative code pertaining to the establishment of management zones and trapping seasons for . beaver.

The proposed rules establish four beaver management zones and trapping seasons as follows:

Zone A - Northwest Wisconsin - Saturday nearest October 21 through March 15.

Zone B - Northeast Wisconsin - Saturday nearest October 21 through April 30.

Zone C - Southcentral Wisconsin - December 1 through March 15.

Zone D - Mississippi River - Day after duck season through March 15.


