# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER OF amending ss. NR 20.02(1)(c) and (2) and 25.06(2)(b)1.; and creating s. NR 20.03(1)(k)1g. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to sport and commercial fishing for yellow perch on Green Bay and its tributaries

## Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.085, 29.174(3), 29.33(1) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085, 29.174(1) and (2) and 29.33(1), Stats.

SECTIONS 1 and 2 reduce the sport fishing daily bag limit for yellow perch from Green Bay and its tributaries from 50 to 25 fish, year round.

SECTION 3 defines that portion of the Sturgeon Bay ship canal which is included in the waters of Green Bay affected by the reduced yellow perch sport fishing bag limit established by SECTION 1.

SECTION 4 reduces the total allowable commercial harvest for yellow perch in zone 1 (Green Bay) for any license year from 475,000 to 400,000 pounds, beginning July 1, 1991.

SECTION 2. NR 20.02(2) is amended to read:

NR 20.02(2) As used in sub. (1), Green Bay shall mean Green bay, Sturgeon bay, Sawyer's harbor ,the Sturgeon bay ship canal from Sturgeon bay to a line located in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4, section 22, T27N, R26E, Door county, commencing at a point on the southwest shore of the Sturgeon bay ship canal directly beneath the center of the Wisconsin public service company power line and extending in a northeasterly direction directly beneath and parallel to the center of the power line to a point on the northeast shore of the ship canal, and the Fox river from its mouth up to the dam at DePere.

SECTION 3. NR 20.03(1)(k)1g. is created to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Daily bag	Minimum length (inches)
lg. Green Bay tributary streams upstream to the first dam or lake.	Continuous	50 in aggregate, of which no more than 25 may be yellow perch	No size limit

SECTION 4. NR 25.06(2)(b)1. is amended to read:

NR 25.06(2)(b)1. The total allowable commercial harvest in zone 1 for any license year may not exceed 475,000 400,000 pounds.

SECTIONS 1, 2 and 3 shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, as provided by s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats., and SECTION 4 shall take effect July 1, 1991, as provided by s. 227.22(2)(b), Stats.
