ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of creating s. NR 20.038 of . the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining . to angling restrictions on waters of the . Lac du Flambeau Reservation .

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(2)(a) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The rule establishes a daily bag limit of 3 for walleye and a 40" minimum size for muskellunge on lakes wholly or partially within the Lac du Flambeau (LDF) Reservation, effective until March 1, 1992, and potentially thereafter if additional agreements with the Lac du Flambeau Band are reached. The rule is the State response to LDF Tribal Resolution 74(91), wherein LDF offers to downgrade its 1991 treaty harvest declarations on 49 off-reservation lakes. The Tribal Resolution will allow the Department to enact a daily bag of 3 walleye on these off-reservation waters, which would otherwise have been subject to a 2 walleye bag limit. A 3 walleye bag limit is known to have wider acceptance, and will minimize the chance of social and economic disruption in the region.

SECTION 1. NR 20.038 is created to read:

NR 20.038 SPECIAL SIZE AND BAG LIMITS FOR LAC DU FLAMBEAU RESERVATION.

- (1) Notwithstanding bag and size limits established by ss. NR 20.02 and 20.037, there is a bag limit of 3 walleye and a minimum size limit for muskellunge of 40", effective until March 1, 1992, on lakes wholly or partially within the following area, commonly known as the Lac du Flambeau reservation:
 - (a) Iron county T41N-R4E sections 1-4, 10-16, 21-28 and 33-36.
- (b) Vilas county T40N-R4E sections 1-3, 10-15, 22-27 and 34-36; T40N-R5E All except NE section 1, NW/NW section 5, NE section 6; T40N-R6E sections 5-8, 17-20 and 29-32.
- (2) The bag limit of 3 walleye and minimum size limit of 40" may be extended by the secretary beyond March 1, 1992 if future agreements are reached with the Lac du Flambeau band which limit their off-reservation harvest goals to a level allowing a state walleye bag limit of 3 when calculated pursuant to s. NR 20.037. Adjustments to the on-reservation bag and size limits shall become effective upon publication of the adjustment in the official newspapers of Vilas and Oneida counties.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 27, 1991

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats,
