ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

.....
IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating s. .
NR 10.01(3)(e)2. of the Wisconsin Administrative .
Code pertaining to 1991 gun deer season in deer . WM-28-91
management unit 61. .
.....

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The proposed rules would repeal the regularly scheduled 2+7 gun deer season for deer management unit 61 and replace it with a 6+3 format. During the first 6 days hunters could kill a deer of either sex. The last 3 days would be antlerless only.

Presently, during the first 2 days a hunter may kill a deer of either sex. The last 7 days is buck only.

SECTION 1. NR 10.01(3)(e)2. is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.01(3)(e)2. Zone "B"

Deer management units 59D,
61, 61B, 61C, 74A and 74B.

a. The Buffalo, La Crosse,
Trempealeau and Pepin county
portions of deer management
unit 61.

Shotgun season
beginning on the
Saturday immediately
preceding the
Thanksgiving holiday
and continuing for 2
consecutive days.

One deer per
season, either
sex.

Firearm season
beginning on the day
immediately after the
shotgun season
described above and
continuing for 4
consecutive days.

One deer per
season, either
sex.

Firearm season
beginning on the day
immediately after the
firearm season

One antlerless
deer per season.

described above and continuing for 3 consecutive days.

b. The Pierce county portion of deer management unit 61.

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 6 consecutive days.

One deer per season, either sex.

Shotgun season beginning on the day immediately after the shotgun season described above and continuing for 3 consecutive days.

One antlerless deer per season.

c. The Jackson, La Crosse and Monroe county portions of unit 59D, and the La Crosse county portion of 74A.

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days.

One deer per season, either sex.

Firearm season beginning on the day immediately after the shotgun season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days.

One buck deer per season.

d. Deer management unit 61B (Trempealeau national wildlife refuge)

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days.

One deer per hunter's choice permit per season.

e. Deer management unit 61C except during closed periods established by s. NR 11.031 (2)(b)

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days.

One deer per hunter's choice permit per season.

Firearm season beginning on the day immediately after the shotgun season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days.

One deer per hunter's choice permit per season.

f. The Vernon county portions of deer management units 59D and 74A, and the Vernon and Crawford county portion of unit 74B.

Firearm season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days.

One deer per season, either sex.

Firearm season beginning on the day immediately after the shotgun season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days.

One buck deer per season.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 27, 1991.

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
