

AMENDING A RULE

To amend Ins 17.01 (3), relating to medical malpractice mediation system fees for fiscal year 1991-92.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Statutory authority: ss. 601.41 (3), 655.004, and 655.61, Stats.

Statutes Interpreted: 655.61 (1), Stats.

The director of state courts has notified the board of governors of the patients compensation fund that no additional revenue is needed to operate the mediation system for fiscal year 1991-92. An emergency rule eliminating the annual mediation fees charged to physicians and hospitals took effect July 1, 1991. This rule corresponds to that emergency rule.

SECTION 1. Ins 17.01 (3) (a) and (b) are amended to read:

Ins 17.01 (3) (a) For physicians -- \$40.00 \$0

(b) For hospitals, per occupied bed -- \$-2.09 \$0

SECTION 2. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This rule will take effect on the first day of the first month after publication, as provided in s. 227.22 (2) (b), Stats.
