ORDER

:

An order of the Accounting Examining Board to create Accy 7.07 of the administrative code relating to the time in which applicants for a certificate as a certified public accountant must file required information.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2) (a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 442.04, Stats.

This proposed order of the Accounting Examining Board establishes a one year time limit in which an applicant must submit information required in order to be granted a certificate to practice as a certified public accountant. The failure of an applicant to submit the necessary information within one year will result in the applicant being required to submit a new application.

In order to receive a certificate to practice as a certified public accountant, an applicant must submit proof of having completed certain required formal education, having passed an examination and having obtained experience in the practice of accounting. An applicant whose application fails to provide the information necessary upon which to determine whether or not the applicant has met the foregoing requirements is contacted and requested to provide the additional information. Such applications are regularly reviewed to determine whether any response has been received. Some applicants either have not replied to the request(s) for additional information or supplied the information more than a year subsequent to the request. This proposed order would make it clear that applications expire after the passage of one year if the necessary information is not supplied within that reasonable time limit.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Accy 7.07 is created to read:

Accy 7.07 EXPIRATION OF APPLICATIONS. If an applicant for a certificate to practice as a certified public accountant does not comply with a request for information related to his or her application within one year from the date the first request for information was made, the application expires. The applicant may file a new application if his or her application expires under this section.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
