ORDER

An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to amend Chir 3.02 (1) (intro.), (a) and (b), (2) and (3) (a) of the administrative code relating to requirements for credential renewal for chiropractors.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5), 227.11 (2) (a) and 446.02 (1) (b), Stats., and s. 440.08 (3) (b), Stats., as created by SECTION 3305 of 1991 Wisconsin Act 39.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 440.08 (3) and 446.02 (1) (b), Stats.

In this proposed order the Chiropractic Examining Board amends its rules relating to the renewal of chiropractic credentials to conform to newly enacted s. 440.08 (3), Stats., and to correct references to renumbered or repealed statutes.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 3.02 (1) (intro.), (a) and (b), (2) and (3) (a) are amended to read:

Chir 3.02 BIENNIAL REGISTRATION. (1) REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL. (intro.) To renew and obtain a new certificate of registration a licensee shall, by December 31 of the even-numbered year following initial licensure and every 2 years thereafter, file with the board department:

(a) An application for renewal on a form prescribed by the board department.

(b) The fee specified in s. ~~440.05 (3)~~ 440.08 (2) (a), Stats.

(2) REQUIREMENTS FOR LATE RENEWAL. A licensee who fails to meet the requirements in sub. (1) by the renewal date shall cease and desist from practice as a chiropractor. Within ~~60 days~~ 5 years following the renewal date, a licensee may renew and obtain a new certificate of registration by filing with the board department ~~requirements~~ the materials specified in sub. (1) and a late renewal fee specified in s. ~~440.05 (4) or (5)~~ 440.08 (3) (a) 1 or 2, Stats.


(3) REQUIREMENTS FOR REINSTATEMENT. (a) Reinstatement following failure to renew. A licensee who fails to renew within ~~one-year~~ 5 years of the renewal date may be reinstated by meeting the requirements in sub. (2), and may be required to take an examination ~~as specified in s. 446.03(8),~~ State prescribed by the board.
