

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION

The Wisconsin Department of Administration proposes an order to repeal Chapter Adm 15, relating to Emergency Number Systems.

Statutory authority: 16.004(1) and 227.11(2).

Statutes interpreted: 146.70(4).

Analysis prepared by Department of Administration:

Chapter 392, Laws of 1977, effective May 24, 1978, created s. 146.70, Stats., relating to establishing a statewide emergency services telephone number system, creating an emergency number systems board in the Department of Administration, granting rule-making authority and imposing a penalty. Subsection (4) read:

"Duties of Department. (a) The department, in consultation with and with the approval of the emergency number systems board, shall promulgate such rules under ch. 227 as are deemed necessary to coordinate and implement this section."

Chapter Adm 15 was created effective August 1, 1982. Effective February 8, 1986, 1985 WisAct 120 repealed and recreated s. 146.70(4), Stats., removing the Department's rule-making authority.

This repeal shall take effect as provided in s. 227.22(2) (intro.), Stats.
