ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

In the matter of amending s. NR 1.30(2), Wis. Adm. Code, pertaining to the provision of overnight lodging facilities in state parks.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: s. 277.11(2)(a), Stats. Statutes interpreted: s. 27.01(2)(c), Stats.

NR 1.30(2) does not permit overnight lodging facilities in state parks other than designated campgrounds, group camps, staff residences and/or cabins at Mirror Lake State Park.

The Department has a Memorandum of Understanding partnership with the Telephone Pioneers of America, Wisconsin Chapter No. 4, to remove barriers, enhance existing facilities, and provide new opportunities for parks and forests visitors with physical disabilities. One of the goals of the Memorandum of Understanding was for the Telephone Pioneers of America to construct and gift to the Department a campground cabin in the Mirror Lake State Park family campground for use exclusively by people with disabilities who generally cannot participate in a traditional camping experience. The overwhelming success of the Mirror Lake cabin prompted the construction of a second campground cabin in the Kettle Moraine State Forest. Both cabins are now used to capacity and there is need for additional cabins throughout the state park system.

NR 1.30(2) must be amended to permit overnight lodging in campground cabins for use exclusively by people with physical disabilities.

SECTION 1. NR 1.30(2) is amended to read:

NR 1.30(2) No overnight lodging facilities other than designated campgrounds, group camps and staff residences shall may be constructed in state parks, except for a cabin:

- (a) Those constructed for use exclusively by people with physical disabilities, with their family or attendant or both, and overnight
 - (b) Overnight lodging in the Seth Peterson cottage, both at Mirror Lake state park.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on March 24, 1994.

The rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2), Stats.
