ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

adopts an . relating . FM-42-94

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board adopts an . order to amend NR 20.02(1)(d)1. and 2. relating . to sport fishing for coho salmon on Lake . Michigan and Green Bay .

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.085, 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085 and 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The order affects Lake Michigan sport fishing rules.

SECTION 1 decreases from 5 to 3 the sport fishing daily bag limit for coho salmon taken from Lake Michigan during April 1, 1995, through March 31, 1996.

Lake Michigan, within the following area: From the end of the south pier at the entrance of the Sturgeon Bay ship canal on a course of 136° from true north for 17.5 statute miles, then west for 16.8 statute miles to the end of the Algoma north pier, then along the north side of that pier to the shore of Lake Michigan, then north along the shore to the base of the south pier at the entrance of the Sturgeon Bay ship canal, then along the south side of that pier to its end.	All year except there is no open season for lake trout.	5 in total of which none may be lake trout <u>and,</u> <u>from April 1, 1995</u> <u>through March 31,</u> <u>1996, no more than</u> <u>3 may be coho</u> <u>salmon</u> . No person may possess lake trout when fishing in this area of Lake Michigan.	10
