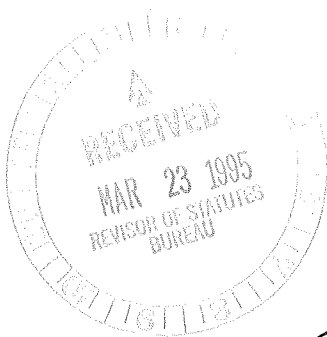

An order of the Medical Examining Board to create Med 10.02 (2) (z) relating to unprofessional conduct.

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ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2), 448.01 (11) and 448.40 (1), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 448.01 (11), Stats.

The Medical Examining Board's rules on unprofessional conduct provide for violation of the board's statutes and rules, and for violation of a board order. However, the rules do not provide for violation of other laws substantially related to the practice of medicine. This proposed rule-making order corrects that oversight in the rules.

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TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Med 10.02 (2) (z) is created to read:

Med 10.02 (2) (z) Violating or aiding and abetting the violation of any law or administrative rule or regulation the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the practice of medicine.



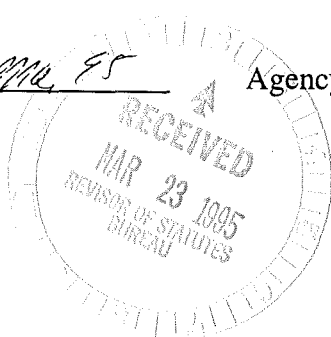

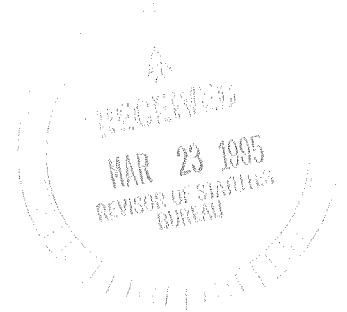
