EXECUTIVE ORDER #150

Relating to the Re-Creation of Nonstatutory Committees

WHEREAS, Section 14.019 of the Wisconsin Statutes recognizes that, under the general powers of the executive, the Governor may create and abolish nonstatutory committees by executive order; and

WHEREAS, any nonstatutory committee created under Section 14.019 expires on the fourth Monday of January of the year in which a new gubernatorial term of office begins, unless the Governor, by executive order, provides for its continued existence;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, do hereby re-create the following entities, effective January 26, 2015:
