## **Initial Regulatory Flexibility Analysis**

The proposed rule will have an effect on small businesses, as defined under s. 227.114 (1).

### **1. Description of the types of small businesses that will be affected by the rule:**

Wisconsin's electrical code applies to a wide range of businesses, including small businesses. Examples include electrical contractors, electrical inspectors, and electricians.

### **2. Description of the proposed reporting, bookkeeping, and other procedures required for compliance with the rule:**

Electrical inspectors will be required to prepare an inspection report and document any compliance deficiencies.

### **3. Description of the types of professional skills necessary for compliance with the rules:**

Electrical contractors, electrical inspectors, and electricians are generally required to be credentialed by the Department of Safety and Professional Services.
