Dear Representative Vos, Senator Roth, and Attorney Grosz,

A statement of scope to revise Wis. Admin. Code ch. PI 36, relating to restoring part time open enrollment rules, was published in Register No. 742A2 under SS 109-17 on October 9, 2017, and approved by State Superintendent Tony Evers on November 21, 2017. Accordingly, the Department submitted a proposed rule, Clearinghouse Rule 18-009 relating to restoring part time open enrollment rules, to the Legislative Council Rules Clearinghouse on January 29, 2018.

Additionally, a statement of scope to revise Wis. Admin. Code ch. PI 38, relating to school-based mental health services grants, special education transition readiness grants, and other changes to state grant programs as a result of 2017 Wisconsin Act 59, was published in Register No. 743B under SS 122-17 on November 27, 2017, and approved by State Superintendent Tony Evers on January 3, 2018. Accordingly, the Department submitted a proposed rule, Clearinghouse Rule 18-012 relating to technical changes to grants for tribal revitalization as a result of 2017 Wisconsin Act 59, to the Legislative Council Rules Clearinghouse on February 5, 2018.

The Department will not be moving forward with revisions to Wis. Admin. Code chs. PI 36 or PI 38 under either Clearinghouse Rule. Therefore, pursuant to the procedures under Wis. Stat. s. 227.14 (6) (b), the Department hereby provides notice of its decision to withdraw Clearinghouse Rules 18-009 and 18-012.
