

EXECUTIVE ORDER #296

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Staff Sgt. Krasean Clayborn of the United States Army

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2018, Staff Sgt. Krasean Clayborn, a member of the United States Army and a native of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, passed away unexpectedly at Caserma Ederle, Italy; and

WHEREAS, Staff Sgt. Krasean Clayborn faithfully served the people of the State of Wisconsin and the United States, joining the United States Navy in 2003 and serving until 2007, and re-entering the military with the United States Army in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Staff Sgt. Krasean Clayborn joined the 173rd Airborne Brigade in 2016, where he served as a paratrooper and career counselor; and

WHEREAS, Staff Sgt. Krasean Clayborn was awarded the Army Commendation Medal and the Army Achievement Medal; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Staff Sgt. Krasean Clayborn; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Staff Sgt. Krasean Clayborn on Saturday, June 23, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution, the laws of this State, and by federal law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on Saturday, June 23, 2018 and ending at sunset on that date.
