Committee Motions for July 19, 2018 Executive Session:

## **Emergency Rule 1806: Agriculture, Trade, & Consumer Protection – Prohibited Noxious Weed Seeds**

- Moved, that the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules, pursuant to s. 227.24 (2), Stats., extend the effective period of an emergency rule of the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, relating to the definition of prohibited noxious weed seeds (EmR 1806 – 1<sup>st</sup> Ext.), for a period of 60 days through September 19, 2018.

## **Clearinghouse Rule 18-027: Public Instruction – Youth Options Program Appeals**
