Not to take a Provided, that said Commissioners shall not enter any lands claim without consent of claim claimed by any individual without his consent.

No. 13.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act relating to the Militia."

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

A Company.

Sec. 1. That the number of men comprising a company of the Militia of this territory, shall consist of not less than forty-five, including officers, non-commissioned officers and privates.

Cooper's Tactics

SEC. 2. That one hundred and fifty copies of the act relating to the militia be printed, and that they together with the copies of Cooper's improved Tactics now in the Territorial Library, be subject to the order of the Adjutant General, for immediate distribution to the officers of the militia, and to the several volunteered companies.

Company muster how notified.

- SEC. 3. That after notice of enrollment, three notices in writing, at least fifteen days previous to the day of any company muster, posted in the most public places, in a company district, by order of the commanding officer of such company, shall be deemed sufficient to compel the attendance of the members of such company for muster.
- SEC. 4. That any law, contravening any of the provisions of this act, is hereby repealed.
 - SEC. 5. This act to take effect from and after its passage. Approved, January 6th, 1840.

AN ACT to exonerate the several counties in the Territory from the payment of certain taxes.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin as follows:
