Powers and duties of the commissioner.

It shall be the duty of the commissioner appointed, under the provisions of this act, to perform all the duties required by the act to which this act is amendatory to be performed by the said three commissioners, and he is hereby invested with the same powers to carry into effect the provisions of the said act, as are, by law, given to the said three commissioners, and he shall qualify and give bonds in the same manner.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act concerning the time of commencing actions."

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

Buits to recover lands sold for taxes barred, When.

SECTION 1. That no suit or action shall be brought in any lands sold for non-payment of court in this Territory, to recover the title or possession to any land which shall be sold for the non-payment of any tax, by any person, unless such swit or action shall be commenced within three years next after the execution and delivery of the deed of the land so sold. Provided, however, that if any person entitled to commence such suit, shall, during any part of saidtime, be an infant, feme covert, lunatic, or imprisoned on any criminal charge, or in execution upon some conviction of a criminal offence, for any term less than for twenty years, such time shall not be deemed any portion of the three years limited for the commencement of such suit.
