Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SEC. 1. That Hamilton Stevens, J. P. Brower, and El- Madison and bert Dickason, be authorised to lay out and establish a territo- Frankfrt read rial road commencing at Madison, the seat of government of this territory, and extending thence, by the nearest and most direct route to Frankfort, in the county of Dodge.

SEC. 2. That said commissioners be required to lay out and How to lay out establish said road agreeably to the provisions of an act, entitled "An act to provide for the laying out and opening territorial roads," approved January 11, 1840.

SEC. 3. The said commissioners shall proceed to lay out When, and establish said road, in the manner above prescribed, within three months from the passage of this act, and not thereafter.
