AN ACT to divide the Town of Lake, and to organise the Town of Oak Creek, and to change the place of holding elections in the Town of Darien, in the County of Walworth.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SEC. 1. That all that part of the town of Lake, in the Town of Oak county of Milwaukee, which is comprised in township five Creek organ. north, in ranges twenty-two and twenty-three east, shall be, and ised. the same is hereby set off into a separate town, by the name of Oak Creek.

> Sec. 2. The town of Oak Creek shall be entitled to [and] enjoy all the rights and privileges which are granted by law to the other towns in this territory.

This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

Sec. 4. That so much of the act organising the town of Voters of Da. Darien, in Walworth county, as requires elections to be held at ignate place of John Bruce's, junior, is, from and after the first day of December next, repealed; and it shall be lawful for the voters of said towh to designate any other place at which the elections shall be held, from and after the time herein mentioned.
