AN ACT to divide the Town of Watertown, in the County of Jeffersen, and to establish the Town of Union.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SEC. 1. That all that part of the town of Watertown, com-TownofUnion prised in townships Nos. seven and eight, in range No. sixteen, in the county of Jefferson, be, and the same is hereby set off into a separate town by the name of Union; which town shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges which other towns are by law entitled to. The first election shall be holden at the First election. house of Benjamin Piper in said town.

> SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. Approved, February 12th, 1841.
